Brief comments

- The two lessons observed demonstrated that pupils are making good progress in Spanish. They have opportunities to build on prior learning and clearly enjoy learning Spanish.
- Subject Lead and link governor are in regular communication.
- Profile of Spanish has been raised on the school website.
- A clear curriculum map which is well thought out ensuring that each year pupils are able to build on prior learning.
- Evidence of strong curricular work in Year 5.
- Plans for sustainability in place – HLTA will be teaching and leading the subject from September. She has Spanish A Level. Sarah will provide a thorough handover.
- There is a clear commitment to Spanish from the school. All children from Nursery-Yr 6 have one hour a week.
- Spanish features prominently on school report with comments being expanded on for pupils working at Greater Depth.
- Spanish word of the week shared in assemblies for whole school which is linked to values.

Areas where the criteria have not been met:

- Bronze and Silver criteria met fully.

Recommendations:

- To embed a cross curricular project in every year group.
- Arrange to team teach, observe and support the HLTA who will be taking over in September during this half term.
- Support teachers further to use Spanish for daily routines.

- Consider implementing Language Captains.
- Continue to try and embed the secondary school link.
